Multiple levels of invisibility

- 1st level: Scientific articles tended to hide (in their keywords, titles or abstracts) the fact that non-scientists participated in (or meaningfully contributed to) research
 - Cooper et al. (2014) The Invisible Prevalence of Citizen Science in Global Research:
 Migratory Birds and Climate Change
- 2nd level: Environmental focus and potentials
 - Knowledge co-creation and participation, SSH
- 3rd level: Explicit CS often coined marginal, actually existing is undefined
 - MoRRI indicators, Mejlgaard et al (2018)


Unequal knowledge production

 A specific form of PPSR – multiple ways of engaging public perspectives and knowledge in scientific discourse and policy-

making (Irwin 1995)

Silences in CEE countries

"The field of citizen science is very new and niche. Only very few would be interested in such issues. On a wider scale, people are not familiar with CS. We are not even trying to translate the term, but people are still gradually getting interested." – Greenpeace activist

"Citizen science will only work if the datagathering, management and presenting platform is well designed, and linked to an interest in data usage (...) in case of soil moisturing it would take some years..." – **Grow Obs.**

Reconceptualisation: "Invisible" Citizen Science

- Invisibility as a manifestation
- How to record the absence?
- What is a replacement for CS in these contexts?

- Rendering the actual volunteer and hobby practices visible - "unused citizen science"
- what kind of knowledge is provided? SSH – "citizen social science"
- reacting to the lack of government activity in a special area of knowledge – "substitute knowledge production"
- specific kind of knowledges not produced by the state/academia: "undone science"

Initial successes in CEE countries


- quality of communication around issues and international recognition
- citizens and NGOs linked through platforms that are managed by professional scientists (data gathering and presenting platforms are the real bottlenecks: though-going, slow, lowquality)
- database under the auspieces of a research group sustainability and survival is an issue
- citizens would like to download, share and curate data
- cultural change in countires where democracy means a short and recent (and questionable) experience, active citizenship has limited tradition, citizen participation is not institutionalized MAKING VISIBLE CITIZEN SCIENCE




More succeses to come

- Initiatives do not explicitly start as citizen science but could be later turned into one. Applications linked to SSH never considered themselves citizen science.
- Good quality amateur and old private photos from people or institutions made publicly available. It enriches your view of the city and the city life in a particular neighbourhood. A common digital heritage and great research opportunities for professionals.


- Budapest and a dozen of other cities
