The questionnaire includes 18 categories, which measure 18 types of motivations. Each category has 1 to 7 items.

Filling the questionnaires takes between 8-15 minutes. Whenever possible we recommend using ALL items.

How to use the questionnaire?

Preparing a project specific questionnaire

Translation

To use the questionnaire in your language you will need to translate it. When translating, meaning is more important than accuracy.

- 1. Translate items to your language.
- 2. Ask 3 scholars with proficient level of English to back translate the items to English.
- 3. Improve translation when necessary.

Project specific items

Items number 2, 19, 31, 49, 55 include the words "topic of this project" or "this project". You can leave them as they are or replace them with the topic of your project, e.g., wildlife, marine biology, Alzheimer disease etc.

Do you need a shorter version?

If you need your CSs to fill in a questionnaire with fewer items follow these steps:

For a shorter version (35 items or more),

- Power, dominance
- Face
- Security
- Tradition
- Teaching

Randomization of items

Whenever possible it is recommended to use a software (online) that allows full randomization of items.

• Participants will receive a link and fill the questionnaire using their smartphones, tablets, or computers.

When using a paper and pencil version, randomize the items before printing the questionnaire.

Analysis

Calculate the 18 motivation categories for each participant by calculating the mean of the category items

• Make sure NOT to include "not relevant" answers in the calculation of the mean.
